SAFETY INFORMATION SHEET AND CUSTOMER/VISITOR PASS

Ross Incineration Services, Inc. receives, stores and incinerates hazardous and non-hazardous materials. Ross Transportation Services, Inc. transports and temporarily stores hazardous and non-hazardous materials. Many of these substances are byproducts of items found in the average American home. However, some of these materials require that special personal protective equipment be worn when handling them. Therefore, there are certain areas where material is being actively processed which will not be accessible to visitors.

Because we care about your safety, there are some general safety rules which you must follow to ensure your safety while at the Ross Incineration and/or Ross Transportation facility ("Facility").

SIGNING IN

Ross Incineration and Ross Transportation are required to account for everyone who enters and leaves the Facility. Therefore, before entering the Facility, you must sign in at the guard gate, located at the main entrance.

For your safety, you must stay with your guide at all times.

STANDARD PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT (PPE)

All persons entering the Facility must wear the following PPE:

- Long sleeved shirts (arm protection is available at the gate);
- Hard soled shoes;
- Steel toes or toe caps are required in certain areas of the facility (if your visit will include these areas, toe protection is required and toe caps will be available at the gate);
- Long pants;
- A hard hat and safety glasses will be given to you when you enter the gate and must be worn at all times;
- Ear plugs, if required, will be provided.

PROHIBITIONS

- Smoking, eating, drinking and chewing gum are permitted <u>only</u> in designated areas.
- No firearms, alcoholic beverages or illegal substances are permitted on site.
- Photographic equipment is prohibited unless specifically authorized by Ross Incineration or Ross Transportation management.
- Cell phone usage is prohibited in all process areas of the Facility. Turn your cell phone off. Designated areas for safe cell phone usage are available; your guide can identify these areas to you.

EMERGENCY EVACUATION

In case of an emergency only, you must go to one of two locations called "rally points":

- The guard shack at the entrance of the Facility.
- North of the maintenance storage tank.

COMMUNICATION

- Feel free to ask your guide any questions you have regarding the Facility.
- If an injury should occur, report it to your guide immediately.

- 1. I have reviewed the safety information provided by Ross prior to my entering the premises of Ross and agree to abide by Ross' safety practices.
- 2. I will only enter areas or offices into which I have been given express permission to enter, I assume the risk of any injury to my person or damage to my property which occurs on or about the premises of Ross, except if caused by the negligence of Ross and/or its directors, officers or employees.
